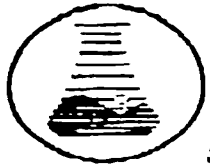


A sample of Scratch-A-Print, a product of Scratch-Art Company, Inc., was examined to determine whether or not the labelling conforms to standards established by the Federal Hazardous Substances Act and by ASTM D-4236.

The product is a screen stencil, available in two sizes. The red coating is transferred to another surface when one writes or draws on the surface with a pen or pencil. This material is water insoluble.

Under normal conditions of use, as described on the package, no chronic health hazards should exist.

Based on my thirty five years of professional experience, I believe this product will not present chronic health hazards to users. Labelling on the package would be adequate once the statement "Conforms to ASTM D-4236" is added.

This conclusion is based on the knowledge that there is no direct contact of the red dye with the skin, and that this red material is insoluble in water.
